## Ginger Cat Glass: Glass Fusing Workshops with Vanessa Thompson Lowe

Ginger Cat Glass has a workshop and studio in Leicestershire where I create handmade fused glass giftware and art. The glass I use in my work is bullseye glass, this is a handmade glass imported from Portland Oregon USA. I use a variety of sheet, stringers and frit glass as well as inclusions of copper foils, wire, metals and silver leaf to create beautiful and interesting pieces of art work.

Come along to a workshop and learn to make and design your own creations in glass. Workshops are designed for beginners and children. All instructions given and individuals catered for, a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 8 per class.

### Workshops

Learn to score and break glass to make decorative shapes and designs with coloured, clear glass, glass frit and stringers. Once you are confident to cut your own glass then you can then begin to design your own piece. These will then be heated in a kiln to produce a smooth or textured look dependent on the heat applied and the finish required to suit your work (kiln work will be done after the class and will be usually ready for collection within approx. 7 days). All basic materials are included in the cost of the workshop. Closed toe shoes must be worn.

£35 per person for a 2 hour workshop.

You will be able to make either:

- ◆ coasters
- ◆ a sun catcher
- ◆ a curve or wave
- ◆ a small bowl

Should you wish to make more items then a further charge for materials will be incurred.
